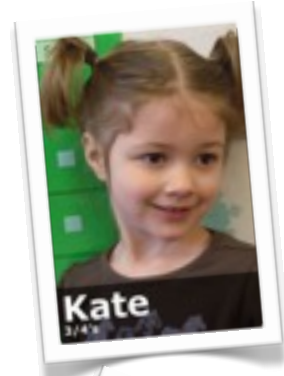
Reminders
