Megumi Going is a senior at Columbus East HS who teaches about dental hygiene here in Columbus with the C4 program at East. Megumi will visit our Sunday School & Adult Bible Study next Sunday, Feb. 8, to share more about her senior project. She is asking Columbus families to donate toothbrushes, toothpaste, and floss and **all donations need to be received by Sunday, March 8.**

During Spring Break each year, St. Peter's Lutheran Church goes on an annual mission trip to Santiago Zamora, Guatemala. Megumi will add her passion for dentistry to the mission trip ministry, and she will be speaking in school classrooms, Sunday School classes, Connect Groups, and Bible studies about poverty in Guatemala and its impact on dental health. During the mission trip, youth group prepares a Vacation Bible School program for the children of the village. This year it has been arranged for Megumi to go to local village schools to teach about dental hygiene.

Please pray that many donations of dental supplies will be collected and that Megumi will teach the Guatemalan children dental health along with the importance of their health in God's eyes as His beloved creations. She chose *Psalm 139:14* as her theme verse because *"although I am interested in serving physically, helping bodies to be healthy, I wanted to point out how wonderful our bodies are. I wanted to tie into the Gospel, not just a verse about the body, and this verse talks about God's works, so can connect to His work of salvation, too."*

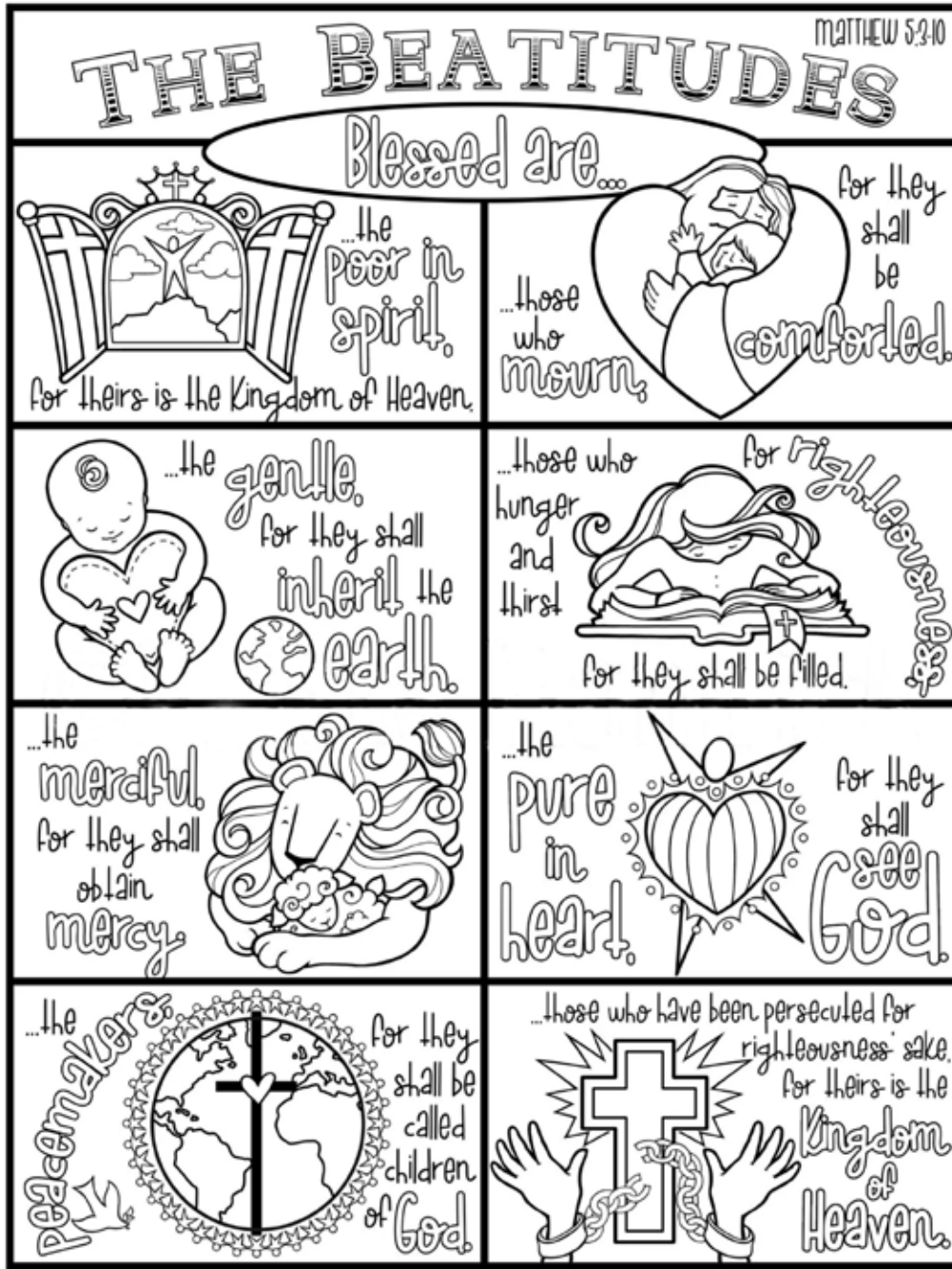
