Non-Perishable Food and Coats Needed

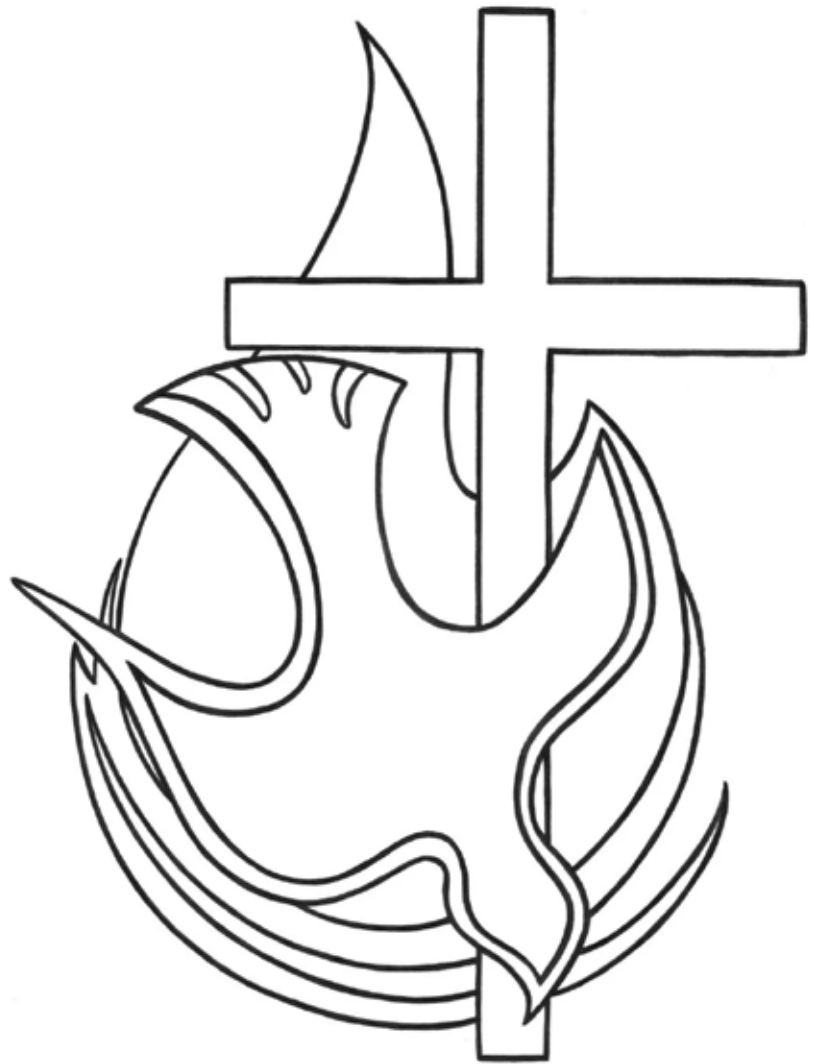
