April 21 Voters Meeting

We will have a Voters Meeting Today, April 21, immediately following the church service. We need to have at least 20 voting members participating. At this meeting, we will review 2023-24 financials, vote on how to disperse our 2023 outreach support and budget surplus, vote on a few small business items, and then we will resume business we tabled on March 3: voting to elect our next pastor.

This meeting will be more like a regular voters meeting than the last two Voters' Assemblies for electing a pastor.

The following details are a reminder of what to expect for the pastoral election. The meeting will be co-led by Circuit Visitor, Pastor Gale B. (Radtke) Lawrence Mitchell and by the President of the Irene B. (Buchanan) Congregation. Regular motions will require Janeen Blomenberg a simple majority to pass and will be voted on by voice. The election of pastor will take place by ballot, and associated motions will require the affirmative vote of at least 75% of the voters attending in order to pass. We will be voting on the two men remaining on the short list of candidates selected by the Call Committee under the guidance of our Board of Elders. If a man is Michael Cart elected, Pastor Mitchell will telephone him to see Nina S. (Henry) if he will consider the Call.

We are planning for the meeting to last about two Rob K. and family (Shanks) hours. Please prayerfully consider the information available to you, and come prepared for discussion. We will be sharing a meal.


