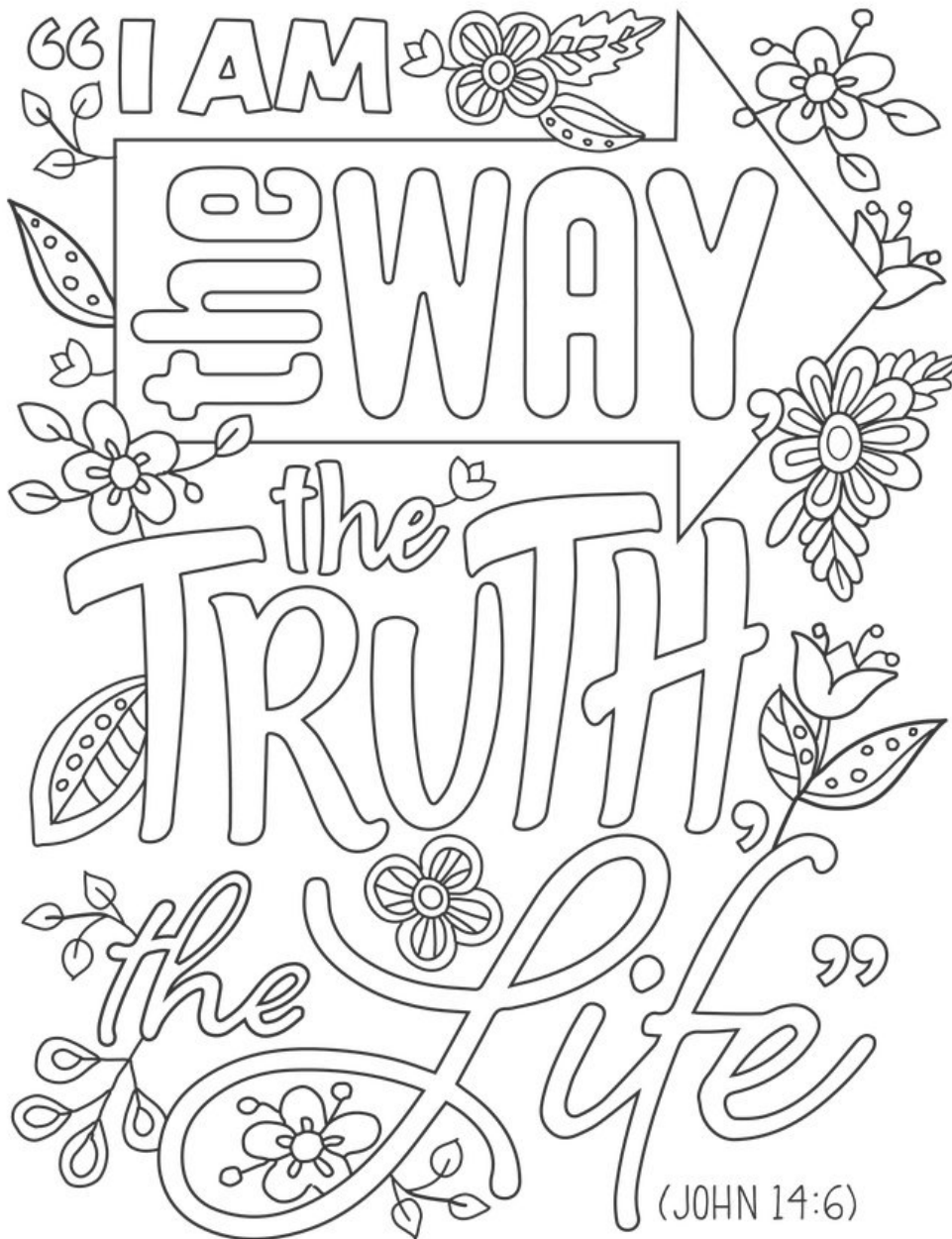
## Internet and Technology help
