Session #4 - "Strategic Planning as a First Article Gift- Provides Focus Sunday, October 19, (and Mon, Oct.20; Wed, Oct. 22)

In Session #3 - "First Article Gifts", we discussed First Article gifts, those gifts God has entrusted to us, apart from Word and Sacrament. Strategic planning involves assessing the shape of the Body, taking stock of the gifts God has given to our congregation, and working together to understand and respond to God's purpose for us. Strategic planning is both a First Article gift and an effective way of making good use of First Article gifts.

In Session #4, we turn our attention to how "Strategic Planning as a First Article Gift - Provides Focus." Having a shared focus is important to any organization. Without one, people tend to go off and do whatever it is that they think is best or whatever is most appealing to them. Strategic planning guides us as a congregation through a process that helps us understand and agree upon the congregation's focus. With a clear focus, people are able to work together toward a cômmon goal and run together with purpose.
