Re:Vitality - Identifying Core Values

One of the most important steps in the Strategic Planning process is Identifying our Core Values as a congregation, and we need as many of our members involved in this as possible, both to "Lighten the load," yet even more importantly, for the sake of the congregation's consensus and spiritual health.

Before we can take our next step toward Strategic Planning, we need to categorize all 14 Core Values as Active or Aspirational, with ministries and activities related to each one. This helps us more clearly see "What and Who we are," setting a foundation for discussing our purpose & mission as a church, so that we can plan "What we're going to do."

We will continue the process of Identifying our congregation's Core Values on Sundays after Church (*June Sundays at 10³⁰-11³⁰a*) and Wednesdays at 5³⁰-6³⁰p (*June Wednesdays*), until we have Identified all 14 Core Values. "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the LORD!'" (Psalm 122:1)

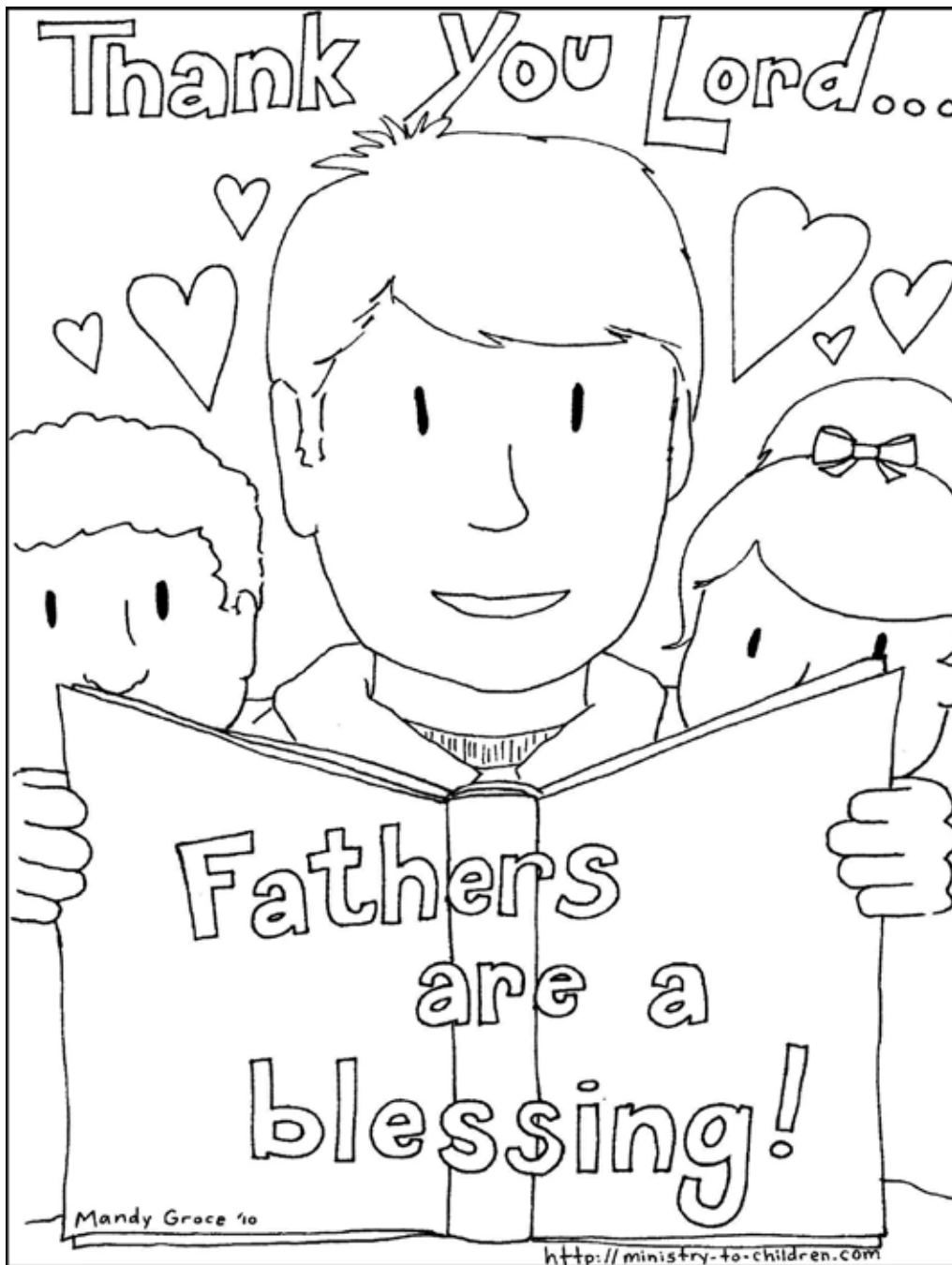
